Q & A - What is this show?

What is this annual show?

Each Spring we rent an auditorium to offer the kids an opportunity to perform on a stage. This show is optional but a Dancercise costume is required to participate.

How long is the show?

The show is around 1 hour consisting of about 6 groups of performers. Each group will have about 12-15 kids.

What will my child perform in the show?

Your child will perform 2 special dances on the stage with their group including their Dancercise teacher and friends from their school. At the end of the show, all the kids go back on stage for the Grande Finale.

What are the kids doing while waiting to perform?

Parents go enjoy the show! The kids are having fun in a designated group area. They are closely supervised by a group leader & entertained with stories, songs & kid movies.

What time is the show?

Your child will perform in **ONE** show. Times will be announced in May. Tentative times are 10:30 am, 1:00 pm, 4:00 pm **OR** 5:30 pm—subject to change slightly.

When do I get my costume?

Costumes will be mailed to your home Mid-May along with show details including a map and show time.

Is my child too young?

This show is specifically designed for pre-school & toddler age kids. Their Dancercise teacher is on the stage dancing with them so they will know what to do. Remember, this is about having fun and building confidence.

What do the costumes look like?

Colors and styles vary, but ALL are age appropriate. Typically girls wear a satin or lamè leotard with a dance skirt or tu-tu. Each trimmed with lace, ribbon or sequins, and include a hair bow. Boys wear satin jazz pants, a jazz shirt with a vest or bow tie & cummerbund, trimmed with sequins.

What shoes or accessories are required?

Comfortable dress shoes or sneakers should be worn. Dance shoes are NOT required, but can be worn if you have them. Girls need white tights (not included).

How do we buy tickets & is there a limit per family?

Tickets to defray auditorium and staffing costs will be sold at the door. There is no limit on tickets. Performers are not charged admission.

Is this costume order refundable?

Costumes are made to order, so we cannot return them. However, we can put your costume on a sell list for the families who missed the order due date. There is no guarantee that we can sell it, but this is often successful.
